It is my sad duty to inform you that Major Peter Brock passed away at his home in Cornwall on March 4th. He was 85.

After service with the British South Africa Police, Peter attended Mons Officer Cadet School in 1968, and was gazetted to the Corps of Royal Military Police in April 1969. Subsequently, he saw service in the UK including Northern Ireland and in Germany. Periods in Command included 176 Provost Company in Londonderry and London District Provost Company. A proud Cornishman, Peter was also a very capable cricketer who played for the Corps.

Peter leaves a daughter, Lisa, and a son and former Army Officer, Sean, his wife having predeceased him.

Dear Friends and colleagues,

It is my sad duty to inform you that Major John Wilson passed away on February 20<sup>th</sup>. He was 83 and his funeral has taken place.

Enlisting in the Royal Military Police in 1961, John enjoyed a full career in the ranks, serving in the United Kingdom, including Northern Ireland, Cyprus, and in Germany. On Commissioning, John would go on to command the Central Volunteer Headquarters at Roussillon Barracks. He retired from the Active List in 1995.

John leaves a widow and three sons: Andrw who served with the Royal Air Force; James who served with the Royal Corps of Signals; and Simon ("Sid"), who is an officer serving with the Royal Engineers.
