2. An email was received from the NatSec as follows:

Good morning all

As is now the customary order of things, the Remembrance events kick start with the official opening of the Field of Remembrance, this year on Thursday 7th November, that will be followed by the Corps and Association Act of Remembrance on Saturday 9th November and culminates with the National act of Remembrance and associated RBL Muster at Whitehall London.

Attendance at the opening of the FoR on the Thursday is strictly a ticketed event, attendees need to at Westminster Abbey by 10:00 hrs - there are always long queues to get in so a sense of humour is required. Those who attend are then permitted to stand behind their respective plot whilst the event is officially opened on behalf of the Nation, there then follows a period of waiting to see the the usually swift stroll past of a member of the Royal Household. Once the Royal has left the informal gathering disperses normally by about 1215 hrs.

It is my privilege to represent our Association at the event, I have applied for 8 tickets and have been granted I believe those 8 spaces - I have to reserve a couple of places for our serving cohort representative to be able to attend, if you and a partner would like to be considered for two of the remaining 6 spaces please do apply - however please note the date is THURSDAY 7th November, it is at Westminster Abbey London and is an all morning affair - why do I stipulate that? Simply because again last year as in previous years I had people apply and were allocated spaces only for them not to bother to turn up on the day, and then to tell me that thy had not realised the date, or decided to go on holiday or turned up to late these are just a few of the reasons given to me for why we had blank spaces as it were.
