7.1 CESA

- 7. 9th November a Service of Remembrance for the Fishing Communities at St. Johns Church on St. Georges Road. Timings to be confirmed.
- 8. The standard holders are to have a Tommy at either side. Associations have been asked to make a donation. JW proposed a £50 donation, only a few where in favour. JM proposed £20 seconded by DK all in favour. A cheque will be sent.

- 9. The RMA are setting up a clay Pidgeon shoot. Cost will be £20 for 75 cartridges. Anyone interested, please let the secretary know.
- 10. RASC/RCTA are having a Scarborough weekend in October. Cost is £116 per person, full board. Saturday 18/19/20 October 2019 Anyone interested please let the Secretary know.
